News & Views - Supports and communicates the purposes, objectives, and business of NAE4-HA to the membership through the quarterly News & Views publication.

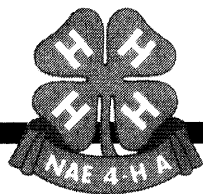
Diversity - Works to make diversity and inclusiveness part of the association's fabric by developing programs to increase awareness and promote positive actions.
